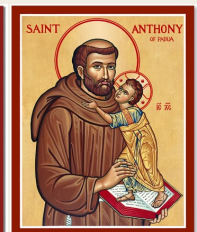

# From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to thank everyone for your patience with me as I was attending to various family events over the past four weeks. It was an honor to preside at the wedding of my brother, and then to preside at the wedding of my cousin, and then to go on a trip to meet my new sister-in-law's family in India, but I am relieved that everything is over and I can now resume a normal schedule.

The trip to India was delightful. The American contingent numbered about 40 members of my family and various friends. We spent three days celebrating with the family of my new sister-in-law at a resort hotel in the city of Jaipur. We then spent four days traveling around a bit. We toured some beautiful palaces, did a bit of shopping in the souq markets, and visited the Taj Mahal. Each day I had Mass in my hotel room for whoever from my family wanted to join. On Sunday we were able to use one of the hotel conference rooms for Mass.

This week has some great feasts in it. All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day are coming up soon. All Saints' Day is Friday, November 1. It is a Holy Day of Obligation. Both of our churches will have a 12:10 pm Mass. Saint Joseph Church will also have a 7:00 pm Mass. All Souls' Day is

on Saturday, November 2. All Souls' Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but it is, nevertheless, a great day to go to Mass to pray for the souls of our departed loved ones. We will be having an 8:00 am Mass at St. Rose Cemetery and a 12:00 pm Mass at Mount Carmel Cemetery. Then we will be having a 7:00 pm vespers service at St. Joseph Church. Since the 7:00 pm vespers service is not a Mass, it does not fulfill the Sunday obligation, but it is a beautiful ritual at which we pray particularly for those people who were buried from St. Joseph Parish this past year.

As I mentioned last week, St. Joseph Parish and St. Anthony Parish will both be participating in the iGiveCatholic Giving Tuesday. This is a nationwide day in which people are encouraged to donate to their Catholic parishes and other Catholic organizations. At the diocesan level, all donations are tracked on an online scoreboard - so it's a bit like a competition between the various churches of the diocese to see who gets the most support. Giving Tuesday is on Tuesday, December 3. I'll be writing a bit more about it next week.

**Christmas Wish List Scrolls for the children of our Food Pantry clients will be available after Masses on Saturday, November 9 and Sunday, November 10.**

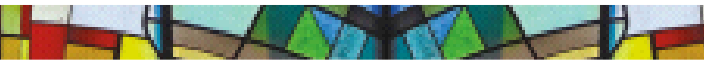
*Scrolls will be located in a basket at each entrance. Each scroll has a child's Christmas wish list, along with a corresponding Child ID#.*

## Treasures From Our Tradition

“What is the Church if not the assembly of all the saints?” wrote the fifth-century bishop Niceta. Each Sunday, in the Profession of Faith, we express our belief in the communion of saints, the one body—with Christ as its head—made up of “those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are being purified and the blessed in heaven.” We are not alone!

The preface for All Saints begins, “For today by your gift we celebrate the festival of your city, the heavenly Jerusalem, our mother.” What astounding words! All Saints Day (like every solemnity) is nothing less than the festival of the fullness of the paschal mystery, our dying and rising in Christ. Of course, now in autumn the mystery comes “clothed” in glorious autumnal garb, and so we celebrate our Easter faith with signs of the harvest, signs of nature’s dying, signs of the “homecoming” that happens naturally when the weather gets cold and families find themselves together more often. While the dying can point to our own mortality, the homecoming reminds us of the mystery of our own resurrection with Christ.

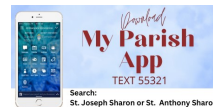
