# From the Pastor

#### Dear Parishioners,

In just two more days we will be celebrating Christmas. We will hear the angel say to the shepherds: "Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger" (Luke 2:10-12). Thus shepherds were told to look for a sign, and this sign is nothing extraordinary: simply a child born in a stable and laid in a feeding trough.

This is for us a sign of how God reigns - he does not come with power and outward splendor, ruling with strength - he wants from us only what this child wants from us - our love. We know that the great command of the old law is "you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." But how are we to love that which seems distant, which we can only catch a glimpse of. At Christmas we celebrate that God is no longer distant, no longer unknown, no longer beyond our reach. He has become our neighbor - and not just any neighbor, but the weakest and poorest among us: an infant. In this way he teaches us to love the weak, to defend the poor, to support those who cannot support themselves. In a world dominated by arrogance and pride, the poverty of God is a message that we constantly need to hear.

If you have not yet made it to confession, I will be in the confessional on Monday from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.




