

From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners

This Sunday is Gaudéte Sunday (pronounced Gow-DAYtay). The name of this Sunday comes from the entrance antiphon of the Mass, which uses Philippians 4:4: "Gaudéte in Domino semper; íterum dico, gaudéte" ("Rejoice in the Lord always; I say it again, rejoice!"). On Gaudéte Sunday we rejoice that the Lord's coming is getting closer. The liturgical color is rose (a shade of pink), to reflect the glimmer of hope as we approach Christmas.

I would like to announce to you a big event that will be happening in the universal Church. This upcoming calendar year - the Year of Our Lord 2025 is a Holy Year of Jubilee. In the Old Testament, God commanded the Israelites to celebrate a "jubilee year" every fiftieth year. During a jubilee year, all debts were forgiven. It was a year of particular rejoicing. In the middle ages, Holy Mother Church, in emulation of the Kingdom of Israel, decided to take up the Old Testament idea of a jubilee year to encourage people to celebrate God's goodness. Since 50 years is too long a period of time, the Church decided to have a jubilee year every 25 years. This way, more people would be able to experience a jubilee.

Traditionally, the jubilee year would be a chance to take a pilgrimage to Rome. In the four great pilgrim basilicas of Rome, there are special doors which are only opened during the jubilee year. Once the jubilee year is finished those "Holy Doors" are bricked-up. The bricks are not removed again until the next jubilee. For those who cannot make a pilgrimage to Rome, every Cathedral is to designate one of their doors as a Holy Door for pilgrims to walk through. Every church around the world will be celebrating the opening of the Jubilee Year next Sunday at the end of Mass.

Lastly, if you haven't gone to confession yet, be sure to put it on your calendar. On Sunday, December 15, there will be two penance services: one at Beloved Disciple (Grove City) at 2:00 pm and one at Immaculate Heart of Mary (Mercer) at 5:00 pm. Then we will be having a penance service at St. Joe's on Thursday, December, 19 at 7:00 pm. Additionally, I will be in the confessional at St. Joe's from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm on the following days: Monday, December 16, Friday, December 20, and Monday, December 23.

Feedback Requested! We would like to hear from our families about their interest in reintroducing Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) at the 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sundays. During CLOW, the children are dismissed from the main assembly with an adult leader and assistant to listen to the readings and Gospel using a biblical translation that is simple, but not childish. They hear a reflection that can help them apply the readings to their lives, and they practice using the responses and prayers used in the Liturgy of the Word. The children return to celebrate the Liturgy of the Eucharist with their families and the general assembly. This ministry will require the help of several volunteers – adults and teens are welcome. Volunteers will need to complete the required Child Protection clearances. 


